POSTER THEME

To enter, illustrate one or more of these ideas to create your poster:

- **Recycled Water in Pacifica:** Describe its benefits. Name the recycled water mascot (a purple water drop), create and illustrate a slogan for using recycled water, illustrate how our recycled water fill station works.
- **California's Water:** Focus on Pacifica's water source – Hetch Hetchy! What makes it great?
- **Xeriscaping:** What native plants and/or drought tolerant plants can beautify and enhance a Pacifica garden?

POSTER SPECIFICATIONS

Use 8½" x 11" non-lined, white paper to illustrate methods of water conservation and/or the importance of **drinking water** – *not to be confused with saltwater/oceans*. Use **BOLD, BRIGHT, BRILLIANT COLORS** using crayons, markers, paints, pencils, fabric, cut paper, watercolors, and more!
